If you choose to view your statements electronically, you understand that you will not automatically receive the Statements in paper form.

You have the right (or option) to have the Statements with images of transactions made available in paper form. You may obtain the Statements on paper by verbally requesting a paper copy at Condon Bank & Trust, or by mailing a signed, written request for a paper copy. All requests should include the account number and date of the Statement you wish to receive as well as your name, address and phone number. Regular statement copy fees will apply.

You have the right to withdraw your consent to receive notification to view the Statements electronically. You may withdraw your consent by signing a Request to Stop viewing electronic Statements. To do so contact (620) 251-5500, ask for the Bookkeeping Department. Requests must be received at least 3 business days prior to next Statement cycle date.

If your electronic mail (email) address changes, you must provide a signed, written notice of such change to Condon Bank & Trust. All changes should include the account number of the statement(s). Your previous and new email address as well as your name, address and phone number.

If your email notification to view Statement(s) is returned to Condon Bank & Trust as a rejected email address, you will be notified by an employee of Condon Bank & Trust either by Phone or United States Postal service, to supply Condon Bank & Trust a valid email address. If no contact is made by either the Condon Bank & Trust or Customer by the next statement cycle, the electronic viewing will be shut off and paper form of Statements mailing will resume.

To access, download and print your Statement(s), you will need to have a personal computer with Internet and email access. You must also have Adobe Acrobat 5.0 or above. Your browser must be equipped for 128-bit encryption. A list of the browser levels that support 128-bit encryption follows:

Netscape for Windows98, Windows 2000, Windows XP and Windows NT

- Netscape Navigator Version 6.0 or higher
- Netscape Communicator Version 6.0 or higher

Microsoft Internet Explorer for Windows 98, Windows 2000, Windows XP and Windows NT

- Internet Explorer Version 5.5 or higher (with Secure Sockets Layer Support)

To access, download and print your Statement(s) with all transactions, you must be enrolled and accepted to Condon Bank & Trust Online Banking.
